Tynemouth Free School Meals

I've welcomed the extra support from the Government following the news free school meals will be extended to every child in families receiving universal credit.

From September next year, in Tynemouth 4130 school age children should benefit. In addition to the roll out of free breakfast clubs, the change will save parents nearly £500 per year per child.

Education needs to be, once again, the ladder of opportunity which stops any child's circumstances or background holding them back.





It's very exciting news that Cedarwood has officially been named as one of 12 charities across England to receive a share of £13.6 million in Department for Food and Rural Affairs (Defra) funding.

Garden Gate Community Glean has been named one of just 12 projects in England to receive Defra funding through the Tackling Food Surplus at the Farm Gate scheme.

The core of the project is to glean fresh produce from local sources and redistribute it to households facing food insecurity, ensuring nutritious food reaches those in need.
